



Oideachas Caidrimh agus Gnéasachta (OCG) (Dréacht 2014/15)

Cúlra

Iarradh ar scoileanna oideachas caidrimh agus gnéasachta (OCG) a mhúineadh in Imlitir 2/95. Moladh do scoileanna polasaí OCG a fhorbairt an t-am sin.

I bhFómhar na bliana 1998 tionóladh cruinniú do thuismitheoirí na scoile. Bunaíodh coiste chun polasaí a fhorbairt. Bhí idir thuismitheoirí, mhúinteoirí agus ionadaithe ó Bhord Bainistíochta na scoile ar an gcoiste seo. Cuireadh dréachtpholasaí le chéile in Earracht na bliana i 1999.

Moladh don Bhord athbhreithniú a dhéanamh ar an dréachtpholasaí seo sa Mheastóireacht Scoile uilig is déanaí a bhí againn.

Cuireadh tús le dréachtpholasaí nua sa scoilbhliain 2013/14 agus leanadh leis an obair i bhfómhar na bliana 2014.

Background

In Circular 2/95 issued by the Department Education, the Minister requested all schools to introduce Relationships and Sexuality Education (RSE) as part of the curriculum. Schools were asked to begin the process of developing a policy for RSE.

A meeting of parents was held in autumn 1998. A committee was formed at this meeting to develop the policy. This committee consisted of parents, teachers and representatives from the Board of Management. A draft policy was drawn up in spring 1999.

The Board of Management was asked to review this policy in our most recent whole school evaluation.

A revised policy was begun during the school year 2013/14 and we continued with this work in autumn 2014.

Cad is Oideachas Caidrimh agus Gnéasachta(OCG) ann?

Is cuid den Oideachas Sóisialta, Pearsanta agus Sláinte (OSPS) an OCG. Tugann an OCG deiseanna structúrtha do pháistí chun an t-eolas, an dearcadh, na luachanna, an creideamh agus na scileanna praiticiúla a fhorbairt atá riachtanach chun caidreamh pearsanta, sláintiúil mar pháistí agus ina dhiaidh sin, mar dhaoine fásta a bhunú agus a chothú.

What is Relationships and Sexuality (RSE) Education?

RSE is part of Social, Personal and Health Education (SPHE). RSE provides children with structured opportunities to develop the knowledge, attitudes, values, beliefs and practical skills necessary to establish and sustain healthy personal relationships as children and, subsequently as adults.

Fealsúnacht Scoil Chualann

Is mian linn atmaisféar sona, spreagúil, sabhálte, cineálta a chothú do chách i Scoil Chualann. Is scoil náisiúnta í an scoil le héiteas Caitliceach. Cuirtear fáilte roimh pháistí nach caitlicigh iad ach atá báúil leis an sainmheon Caitliceach atá sa scoil. Cothaítear meas tríd an scoil ar chreideamh, ar thraidisiún, ar chultúr agus ar theanga gach páiste, gach páiste. Tá spiorad agus meon na scoile an-tábhachtach maidir le fás agus forbairt an pháiste. Cuireann atmaisféar grá agus measa, comhbhróin agus maithiúnais go mór le féinmhuinín agus féinghrá na bpáistí . Múintear an clár OCG i gcomhthéasc éiteas na scoile, mar chuid de chlár theagasc Críostaí na scoile, mar chuid de chlár OSPS na scoile agus ar bhonn imeasctha traschuraclaim.

Scoil Chualann's Philosophy

- *To foster an understanding of and a healthy attitude to human sexuality and relationships in a moral, spiritual and social framework*
- *To develop and promote in the child a sense of wonder and awe at the process of birth and new life*
- *To enable the child to be comfortable with the sexuality of oneself and others while growing and developing*
- *To enable the child to acquire an understanding of and respect for human love, sexual intercourse and reproduction*

Objectives

The RSE curriculum should enable the child to:

- *Acquire and develop knowledge and understanding of self*
- *Develop a positive sense of self-awareness, self-esteem and self-worth*
- *Develop an appreciation of the dignity, uniqueness and well-being of others*
- *Understand the nature, growth and development of relationships within families, in friendships and in wider contexts*
- *Develop an awareness of differing family patterns*
- *To come to value family life and appreciate the responsibilities of parenthood*
- *Develop strategies to make decisions, solve problems and implement actions in various personal, social and health contexts*
- *Become aware of the variety of ways in which individuals grow and change and understand that their developing sexuality is an important aspect of self-identity*
- *Develop personal skills which will help them to establish and sustain healthy personal relationships*
- *Develop some coping strategies to protect themselves and others from various forms of abuse*
- *Acquire and improve skills of communication and social interaction*
- *Acquire and use an appropriate vocabulary to discuss feelings, sexuality, growth and development*
- *To develop in the child a critical understanding of external influences on lifestyles and decision making*

An Clár OCG mar a mhúinfear i Scoil Chualann é

1. Múinfear an clár mar chuid den OSPS (OCG, Bí Sábhailte agus Misneach) agus mar chuid den rang Teagasc Críostaí.
2. Beidh an clár comhtháite le réimsí eile an churaclaim (m.sh.eolaíocht, corpoideachas, ceol, drámaíocht, ealaín).
3. Múinfear na gnéithe sin den chlár go bhféadfadh daoine a bheith faichilleach fúthu (fás agus athrú, beatha nua) roimh an mbriseadh lárthearma sa dara téarma.
4. Cuirfear tuismitheoirí ar an eolas roimhré faoi ábhar na gceachtanna.
5. Beidh fáil ag tuismitheoirí ar ábhar na gceachtanna má tá an t-ábhar uathu.
6. Má bhaintear úsáid as dvd chun ceacht a mhúineadh tabharfar deis do na tuismitheoirí breathnú air má tá an fonn sin orthu.
7. Iarrfar ar aoi-chainteoir labhairt faoi gnéithe áirithe den chlár le Rang 6 chun breis eolais a thabhairt do na páistí agus chun daingniú a dhéanamh ar an méid atá múinte cheana féin. Beidh an t-aoichainteoir ar an eolas faoi pholasaí OCG na scoile. Beidh an múinteoir ranga/an Príomhoide i láthair ag an gcaint seo.
8. Tabharfar deis do na tuismitheoirí éisteacht leis an méid a bheidh le rá ag an aoichainteoir ag cruinniú roimh-ré.
9. Iarrtar ar thuismitheoirí labhairt lena bpáistí faoi ábhar na gceachtanna OCG.
10. Muna bhfuil tuismitheoir ag iarraidh go mbeidh a p(h)áiste i láthair ag rang foirmiúil OCG is gá dóibh é sin a chur i scríbhinn chuig an Príomhoide. Déanfar socrúithe don pháiste nach bhfuil ag freastal ar an rang OCG. Iarrfar ar an bpáiste obair scoile a dhéanamh i rang eile.
11. Míneofar do na páistí nár chóir ábhar na gceachtanna maidir le caithreachas, caidreamh collaí, agus breith linbh a phlé le na deartháireacha, na deirfiúracha atá níos óige, le páistí eile sa chlós, nó le cairde taobh amuigh den scoil. Cuirfear ina luí orthu gurb é seo ról an tuismitheora/caomhnóra/múinteora.
12. Beimid ag súil go léireoidh gach duine meas ar a chéile le linn na gceachtanna seo agus go dtuigfidh na páistí nár chóir eolas príobháideach a nochtadh. Ní lorgóidh múinteoirí eolas príomháideach ó na páistí agus ní nochtfaidh siad eolas pearsanta dóibh.
13. Cuirfear tuismitheoirí/caomhnóirí ar an eolas má cheaptar go mbainfidh páistí tairbhe as eolas breise ó na tuismitheoirí/caomhnóirí.
14. Má chuireann páistí ceist cuirfidh an múinteoir/aoichainteoir na rudaí seo a leanas san áireamh agus iad ag freagairt na ceiste
 - An chúis gur cuireadh an cheist
 - An t-eolas atá ag teastáil
 - Aois an pháiste
 - An clár rangaSa chás nach bhfuil an t-eolas oiriúnach don rang ar fad molfar don pháiste an cheist a chur sa bhaile nó míneofar dóibh go bpléifear an t-ábhar seo i rang níos sinsearaí.
15. Leanfaidh an múinteoir na moltaí don tuairisciú ar ábhar imní nó ar nochtadh eolais mar atá luaite i bPolasaí um Chaomhnú Páistí na scoile sa chás go nochtann páiste eolas.
16. Déanfaidh an scoil gach iarracht comhoibriú le haon mhúinteoir nach bhfuil ag iarraidh gné éigin den chlár a mhúineadh. Déanfar na socrúithe cuí ag tús na scoilbhliana.

Relationships and Sexuality Education in Scoil Chualann

- 1. The programme will be taught as part of the SPHE programme (RSE, Stay Safe, Walk Tall) and as part of Religious Education.*
- 2. The programme will be integrated with other areas of the curriculum (eg. science, PE, music, drama, art)*
- 3. The more sensitive themes of the programme (growth, new life) will be taught before the mid-term break in the second term.*
- 4. Parents will be informed in advance of the programme content.*
- 5. The lessons will be made available to parents on request.*
- 6. If a DVD is used to complement the lessons, parents will be offered the opportunity to view same.*
- 7. A guest speaker may be asked to speak to 6th class about the more sensitive areas of the programme to give the children further information and reinforce lessons which have been already taught. The guest speaker will be aware of the school RSE policy. The class teacher will be present for this talk.*
- 8. The parents will have an opportunity to listen to the guest speaker before he/she speaks to the class.*
- 9. Parents will be asked to discuss RSE lessons with their children.*
- 10. If a parent wants their child to be withdrawn from any RSE lesson they must inform the principal in writing. The school will facilitate parents by arranging for the child to be sent to another classroom to work independently.*
- 11. It will be explained to the children that it is inappropriate to discuss certain lesson content's (puberty, sexual intercourse and childbirth) with younger siblings, with other classes in the yard or with friends outside of school. It will be impressed upon them that this is a parent's/guardian's/teacher's role.*
- 12. We will expect a respectful attitude from all during these lessons and that children should recognise that personal disclosures are inappropriate. Teachers will neither give nor request personal information from children.*
- 13. Parents will be informed if the teacher feels that a particular child would benefit from more in-depth discussion of a topic covered.*
- 14. The teacher/visiting speaker will take the following into account when answering children's questions:*
 - The circumstances in which the question has arisen*
 - The information required*
 - The child's age*
 - The class programme being covered*

The child may be asked to ask the question at home or it will be explained to them that the subject will be discussed when they are in a more senior class.
- 15. In any case of disclosure of abuse the teacher/visitor will follow the School Policy on Child Protection.*
- 16. The school will endeavour to accommodate the wish of any teacher who does not wish to teach a particular topic. Arrangements for RSE classes will be discussed at staff level at the beginning of the school year.*

Traenáil do mhúinteoirí

Training for Teachers

Teachers will be invited to take part in courses related to RSE. The programme will be discussed at staff meetings at the beginning of the school year and at the beginning of the second term.
