Fógraí/Bileoga/litreacha Notices/Leaflets/Letters

Iarrtar ar thuismitheoirí/chaomhnóirí:

Tástálacha Caighdeánacha/Standardised tests

Tugann na páistí faoi tástálacha caighdeánacha sna ranganna 1-6 i Scoil Chualann. Tugtar na torthaí do thuismitheoirí sa tuairisc scoile. Tugann na torthaí eolas dúinn ar do pháiste agus iad i mbun foghlama. Cabhraíonn na torthaí linn a chinntiú go bhfuil tacaíocht ar fáil don pháiste más gá .

Ní oireann scrúdaithe caighdeánacha do gach páiste. Bíonn cuid acu neirbhíseach agus tagann laghmhisneach orthu. Bíonn cuid eile mall ag scríobh agus ní éiríonn leo an scrúdú a chríochnú rud a chuireann isteach ar na torthaí. Éiríonn go maith le cuid eile ach ní bhíonn cuma ró-íontach ar an obair ranga. Is gá dúinn na páistí seo a spreagadh. Cuireann an scór tástála gnóthachtáil do pháiste in iúl.

Cuimhnigh gur féidir le thuismitheoirí/caomhnóirí páistí a spreagadh chun tuilleadh léitheoireachta agus cluichí matamaitice a dhéanamh le linn laethanta saoire an tsamhraidh. Ní dhéanfaid sé aon dochar beagán ama a chaitheamh le táblaí freisin.

Ní chuidíonn sé le páistí go mbíonn thuismitheoirí ag plé torthaí lasmuigh den scoil.

Ní chóir torthaí páistí a chur i gcomparáid lena chéile. Tá gach páiste éagsúil agus oibríonn siad de réir a gcumais féin.

Má tá imní ar thuismitheoir faoi thorthaí pháiste is féidir labhairt leis an múinteoir ranga. Déanaimid ceiliúradh ar bhuanna gach páiste i Scoil Chualann agus tógaimid ar na buanna sin. Tá buanna speisialta ag gach páiste. Ba choir dúinn na buanna seo a aithint agus a cheiliúradh.

Standardised tests are completed in classes 1 to 6. Results are given in the school report.

The results give us information about your child as a learner. These results help us as teachers to ensure your child is given support should they need it.

Standardised tests do not suit every child. Some children can worry about the test and underperform. Others may write slowly and not complete the test on time. This affects their result.

Each test score is an indication of your child's achievement in that particular test. They may perform better in class tests. Some children may perform better in standardised tests.

Some children achieve very high scores on standardised tests but their class written work can be disappointing. We need to encourage these children to strive to improve their class work. The class teacher will have monitored your child's progress since the beginning of the school year.

Teacher observation, informal class testing, parents' observations and standardised test results give a clearer picture of your child's progress.

You have an important role to play in encouraging and supporting your child regardless of test results. The children should be encouraged to read and to play mathematical games during the summer break. Five minutes of maths tables per day would benefit some children.

It is not helpful to discuss children's standardised test results with other parents.

Results should not be compared. Children learn at different rates according to their ability. If you have concerns please talk to the class teacher.

We celebrate and nurture the unique qualities of every child in Scoil Chualann. Every child has their own talents. We should celebrate all their achievements.
